**Fuels the Physics Factory**

MINNEAPOLIS, MINNESOTA, July 21, 2006 – When the Physics Factory, a science museum on wheels, rolls into Boston tomorrow, Restaurant Technologies, Inc. (RTI), a leading provider of bulk cooking oil management services to the food service industry, will donate 100 gallons of waste vegetable oil to keep the exhibit moving down the road.

An Arizona based non-profit organization, The Physics Factory is a traveling multi-colored bus filled with science experiments made from everyday objects whose purpose is to excite children about science. The bus itself is a science experiment – fueled by donated waste vegetable oil that is converted to diesel fuel using an old 55-gallon fuel tank and a pressure cooker.

“It is our pleasure to donate waste vegetable oil to the Physics Factory,” said Jeffrey R. Kiesel, chief executive officer at RTI. “What an amazing educational tool to demonstrate the benefits of recycling waste oil into a usable fuel source. As RTI removes waste oil from our customer sites, we work with larger bio-fuels companies to make a sustainable, positive impact on the environment. The Physics Factory’s ‘veggie fuel’ is just one example of how we can improve the environment using alternative fuel sources.”

The Physics Factory in late June began a cross-country tour from Arizona to New York. As part of its “Science is Cool” tour, the bus will visit Boston, MA on July 22<sup>nd</sup> where it will be re-fueled with “veggie fuel” donated by RTI.

“Raising a child’s interest in science can be a challenge, especially if they’ve only experienced ‘science’ through a textbook,” said Erik Herman, president and co-founder of the Physics Factory. “Our traveling Physics bus gets their attention with huge sparks, invisible forces, smoke, lasers, and other amazing phenomena. We appreciate the generosity of our many sponsors, such as RTI, who have given us the opportunity to make science fun.”
