What happens next?

I am getting tested or have been tested to confirm if I have COVID-19

While you wait for your results

YOU ARE PERMITTED TO WORK UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS*:

- You wear a mask when around others for 10 days following exposure
- You discuss a staggered schedule with your manager to reduce exposure to other employees
- You continue to monitor symptoms daily prior to entering the facility
- You remain completely symptom free (Please see the symptom document for further guidance)

MY TEST WAS POSITIVE

MY TEST WAS NEGATIVE

You should notify your supervisor and go home immediately

Medical professionals gave me a note stating when I could return to work

YOU MAY RETURN TO WORK WHEN YOU HAVE MET THE BELOW CRITERIA:

You should notify your Manager of your return to work date and stay home until that date

* If you decide to test after the first 5 days and test positive, continue to stay home for the full 10 days

- At least 5 days have passed since you tested positive or started showing symptoms*
- You do not have a fever
- Other symptoms have improved
- **UPON RETURNING TO WORK, YOU MUST WEAR A MASK FOR AN ADDITIONAL 5 DAYS**

* If you reside in Virginia, local regulations require that you stay home from work while you wait for results
