

Q: I HAVE TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19. WHAT SHOULD I DO?

A:

If you have been diagnosed with the virus, you are required to isolate from others. Inform your manager and provide documentation of positive diagnosis.

If you are either currently showing or have previously shown symptoms, use the COVID-19 symptoms flow chart to determine when you may return to work.

If you tested positive and have not demonstrated symptoms (you are asymptomatic), use the [COVID-19 Exposure flow chart](#) to determine when you may return to work.

You can expect to be contacted to investigate what other employees, if any, you have been in contact with while potentially contagious.
